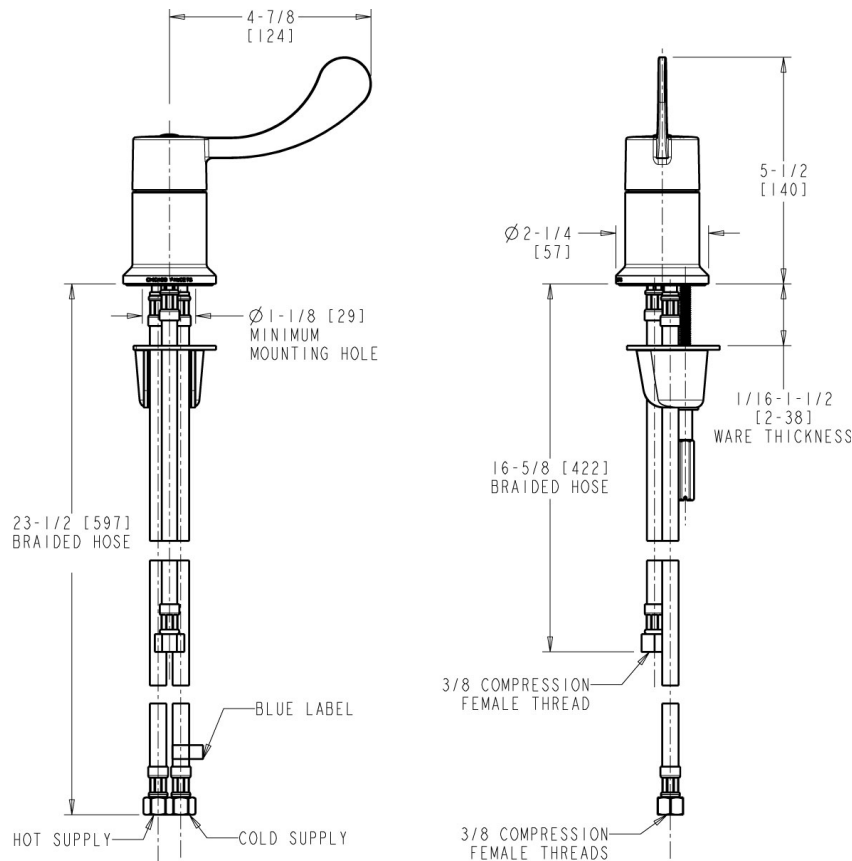

**Architect/Engineer Specification**

Chicago Faucets No. 116.587.AB.1, Exposed Mechanical Mixing Valve with User Control, chrome plated. ADA and HCAI-compliant deck mounted unit. For single-hole, single-supply HyTronic installations. ADA and HCAI-compliant 4" blade handle with hot/cold index. Cast brass valve body. Stainless steel braided inlet and out hoses (included). Includes: inlet check valves, mounting hardware. ECAST® construction with less than 0.25% lead content by weighted average.



**Operation and Maintenance**

Installation should be in accordance with local plumbing codes. Flush all pipes thoroughly before installation. After installation, remove spout outlet or flow control and flush faucet thoroughly to clear any debris. Care should be taken when cleaning the product.
